



EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

As of November 10, 2017, the Byron-Gaines Utility Authority is accepting applications for a full-time Waterworks System Operator. The primary responsibilities of this position include: operations and maintenance of the public water and sanitary sewer systems, buildings and grounds projects, and special projects that are assigned by a supervisor.

This position requires the successful candidate to possess the following:

- A high school diploma
- Previous experience in utility operations, maintenance, or construction
- A valid Michigan driver's license
- The ability to obtain a Waterworks System Operator S-4 certification within 24 months of hire.

In addition, any of the following are preferred: a Michigan Plumbing Inspector Certification, Michigan Waterworks or Wastewater Operator Certifications, or an ASSE Backflow Tester Certification.

Compensation, in the range of \$43,000 - \$50,000 annually, will be based on experience and licensing. A complete benefit package is available.
